

Campership Application

Thank you for your interest in Camp Hidden Meadows. Camp Hidden Meadows has been a summer retreat for children for more than 30 years. We deeply believe in the value of camp - time spent away from home is a unique opportunity to expand one's horizons, learn new and exciting skills, and make long-lasting friendships. We also recognize that the cost of attending a session may be beyond the reach of some families.

To help make camp more accessible, the Camp Hidden Meadows Campership Fund was established in 2022. The Fund provides tuition assistance to families who would not otherwise be able to afford a session of Camp Hidden Meadows for their child.

Camperships are awarded based on financial need and camper program fit and as such, we ask that all applicants do their best to truly assess their ability to contribute to camp tuition. The mission of our Campership program is to enable campers to attend whose families have no other means of sending their child to camp. If you have support from other family members or friends who are willing to contribute to your child's tuition, please consider that when completing your application.

Guidelines:

- Camperships are available for any session depending on availability.
- Camperships are only available for one session.
- Camperships are limited based on available funds each year. Partial Camperships are our only form of Campership. All families will be required to contribute a portion of tuition.
- Once a Campership has been granted, we will attempt to prioritize that camper in future years should they 1) want to come back for an additional summer, 2) still have financial need (validated by a new application each year) and 3) were a positive addition to the camp community the previous summer (i.e. no behavioral issues). Please note that no guarantee can be made for future campership awards. This is only a commitment of intention to prioritize previous recipients to encourage a multi-summer experience.

If your child receives a Campership, we would very much appreciate hearing from you, or your child, about their experience at camp. A note, letter, or email recounting their favorite activities, adventures, or memorable moments can be a tremendous help with future fundraising efforts. Sharing a parent or camper's authentic voice describing camp to potential donors can aid us greatly in securing future contributions.

A child's summer camp experience includes new friendships, fun, challenges, and personal growth. We hear from parents consistently that their child returned home with a deepened sense of responsibility for oneself, others, and the environment. There is no better feeling than making that experience a reality, so we look forward to reviewing your Campership Application.



The deadline for Campership Applications is May 1, 2024. Please allow 1-3 weeks for application review and processing. Applications received after the deadline will be reviewed only if additional funding is available.

To apply for a Campership, please complete and return the following to the Camp Hidden Meadows office:

- A completed Campership Application.
- Documentation of financial need (IRS Form 1040 from most recent year). If this is not available by the deadline, please estimate the current amount on the Campership Application and also include a copy of Form 1040 for the most recent year available.
- Information regarding any unique circumstances not reflected in the application materials. The more information you can provide, the easier it is for us to make decisions that are consistent with the goals of the program.
- A completed Reference Letter (for new applicants only).
